

WHAT TO EXPECT

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT FROM US:

- Our classroom capacities will be limited to allow for social distancing.
 - In classrooms, children will have specified spaces where they are asked to remain. This will include areas such as hula hoops, chairs, spots on the floor, etc., to help them maintain some social distancing while in our care.
 - Our classrooms will have hand sanitizer and disinfectant spray as well as in the common areas. All surfaces will be disinfected before/after all service times, including toys.
 - If we had items in a classroom that don't have a hard surface it can't be sanitized and has been removed from the room, such as books, games, puzzles, and dress up clothes.
 - We will not have small groups for K- 5th grade. It will all be in a large group setting. 2 yr old to 5 yr olds will engage in Large group activities. When we do small groups the children will be socially distanced.
 - Nursery volunteers will be the childcare caregiver to the same child the whole time. Comforting, diaper changing, bath room, ect.
 - No materials or papers will be sent home with kids.
 - Volunteers will be asked specific health questions, have their temperature checked and wear masks while they are interacting with children
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WHAT WE EXPECT

What we expect of you:

Check in :

- Face coverings are highly recommended for children.
- While waiting to check-in, each family will be asked specified health questions as each child's temperature will be taken with a no-touch forehead thermometer. If even one area of the criteria is not met for one person in a family, the entire family will not be permitted to check-in their children.
- Children may not bring in any personal items (besides a bottle) No diaper bags, coats, etc. Everything will stay with the parents.
- Once the child has been checked in we will have room runners to escort children to their rooms. (No adults unless volunteering in the children's area) We will have children and runners use hand sanitizer before and after each delivery and remain socially distanced.

When picking up your child(ren):

- We ask that only one member of your family come to the check in area and give the name/room/ tag number of who they are picking up. We will use walkie/talkie to communicate with all children rooms. We will have runners escort children to the family.

STAY HOME if any of you can answer 'yes' to the following questions:

- Do you or anyone in your household display any of the following symptoms: cough, Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell
- To the best of your knowledge, have you or anyone in your household been in close proximity (6 feet or less) of someone diagnosed with Covid-19 the last 24 hours or have been tested?

** If you answered "yes" to any of the above questions, please consider being tested for Covid-19 and/or self-isolating for the next 14 days.

- Expect us to take your child's temperature as part of the check in process. We cannot check-in a child with a temperature greater than 100.4F.
- To extend grace as these are new processes and procedures, this is a learning experience for everyone, and we want to welcome back everyone to Faith Kids as safely as possible!
