



Technical Arts Coordinator

Reports to: Director of Technical Arts Central

Classification: Full-time Non- Exempt (40 hours)

Supervision Responsibility: None

This **Technical Arts Coordinator** will provide leadership in the areas of audio visual and lighting as it relates to Faith Church and Faith Church ministries. This person will work closely with the pastors, worship leaders, musicians, technicians, and volunteers.

This leadership will come from:

- A personal commitment to the Lordship of Jesus Christ.
- A mature faith and steadfast character.
- A reliance on the authority of Scripture and prayer.
- A sense of calling to an "equipping of the saints."

Core Function: The **Technical Arts Coordinator** will live out their discipleship to Jesus Christ by working with the leadership of Faith Church to implement the vision of the church: "Restoring the World One Relationship at a Time."

Key Roles:

- Provide technical support at Faith Church Dyer for services and special events: room set-up, equipment set-up and operation, troubleshoot technical issues, provide on-site audio, video and lighting services.
- Support the needs of the Faith Church staff with production systems throughout the building during the week as assigned.
- Provide routine equipment maintenance to technical systems throughout Faith Church Dyer location.
- Ability to learn and become proficient in all of the technical equipment: audio, video, lighting, ProPresenter, Planning Center, Ross Dashboard, Vista3 and Dante Audio Networks.
- Ability to train and shepherd technical arts volunteers in assigned areas.
- Prepare the technical arts volunteer schedule using planning center.
- Systems Operation - Learn and become proficient on all Faith Church.
- Participate and contribute in future planning of technical arts through research and recommendations as requested.
- Additional duties as assigned

Competencies:

- Working knowledge and technical skills for cameras, audio for video and lighting.
- Knowledge of current trends for audio, video and lighting.
- Ability to meet deadlines.
- Exhibits a spirit of cooperation, teamwork and teach ability.
- Ability to recruit, train, support and manage volunteers.
- Demonstrates ability to interact with all of Faith Church ministries

- Ability to lift equipment up to 50 lbs.

- Associate Degree in one of the following fields: Audio Production, Communications, Electronics, Media, or Music Technology (Bachelor Degree preferred)

Experience: 2-5 years of relevant experience is preferred.
