The **Worship Leader** will provide leadership and direction for song selection, arts inclusion, and other worship service elements outside of the sermon. They will also provide assistance, based on their gifting, to overall worship efforts of Faith Church. The Worship Leader will work closely with the Pastors and the Director of Worship & Arts.

This leadership will come from:

- A personal commitment to the Lordship of Jesus Christ.
- A mature faith and steadfast character.
- A reliance on the authority of Scripture and prayer.
- A sense of calling to an "equipping of the saints."

**Core Function:** The **Worship Leader** will live out their discipleship to Jesus Christ by working with the leadership of Faith Church to implement the vision of the church: "Restoring the World One Relationship at a Time."

## Key Roles:

- Support, empower and encourage instrumentalists, vocalists and production team members while helping to create and shape a healthy thriving worship ministry
- Identify and cultivate leadership skills in others through mentoring relationships and arranging additional leadership development opportunities
- Provide pertinent information and music to Worship Team members each week in the online Planning Center; Communicate with technical arts volunteers to ensure appropriate preparation and coverage
- Recruit, select, develop, shepherd and schedule technical arts and worship team volunteers. Oversee personnel at weekend worship
- Promote an inter-generational worship atmosphere through music selection, a unique mix of hymns and current worship songs
- Provide a humble, consistent presence through up-front leadership of the Worship Team at the majority of Sunday and special services throughout the year with a primary focus on ushering others into Worship
- Oversee all areas of preparation and production; including audio, lighting, presentation slides, service management, equipment maintenance and online presentation, coordinate stage décor, graphics, and programming elements
- Provide leadership and direction for song selection, arts inclusion and other worship service elements that support the weekend services
- Participate in production meetings with campus leadership and engage with Director

of Technical Arts to network and provide formal updates

- Contribute weekly to the 4 M's and conduct evaluations of worship services, and make adjustments as needed
- Collaborate and directly contribute to the creative process of weekend services and special services and events for Faith Church as a whole to drive creative elements that enhance the worship experience.
- All other duties as assigned
